REQUIREMENTS REGISTRATION FOR REGISTERED FOREIGN ARCHITECTS (RFA)

AS REGISTERED FOREIGN ARCHITECTS (RFA) IN NEGARA BRUNEI DARUSSALAM

- 1) A registered ASEAN Architect (AA) may apply to the Board of Architects, Professional Engineers & Quantity Surveyors (BAPEQS) to work as a Registered Foreign Architect (RFA) in Negara Brunei Darussalam.
- 2) An AA applying for registration as Registered Foreign Architect (RFA) is required to hold a valid Practicing Certificate of the country of origin.
- 3) An AA applying for registration as Registered Foreign Architect (RFA) is required to submit declaration by Architect who is an AA as well as registered with BAPEQS with a valid Practicing certificate who shall be the designated Architect with whom he/she intends to work in collaboration.
- 4) An AA shall apply for RFA registration with not more than one designated Architect at any time but the designated Architect shall be the lead consultant in all projects implemented in Negara Brunei Darussalam.
- 5) An AA applying for RFA registration shall do so on his/her own account and he/her shall not be a director, partner, employee or representative of any person, organization, corporation, partnership or any other form of business in Negara Brunei Darussalam.
- 6) The designated Architect from Brunei Darussalam shall confirm that he/she shall collaborate with the RFA applicant on his/her own account, and not as a director, partner, employee or representative of any person, organization, corporation, partnership or any other form of business in Negara Brunei Darussalam.
- 7) Application for registration must be submitted on the prescribed forms issued by the BAPEQS with the prescribed fees. The application must be legibly written in ink or type-written and submitted with a recent passport size photograph.

- 8) Application for registration must be accompanied by photocopies of documents certified as a true copy by the magistrate court of the country of origin of the applicant
- 9) A successful applicant shall be authorized by BAPEQS to work as a RFA in Brunei Darussalam, not in independent practice, but in collaboration with a designated local Architect with a valid Practicing Certificate in accordance with the provisions of the ASEAN Mutual Recognition Agreement on Architectural Services and shall be bound by the Architects, Professional Engineers and Quantity Surveyors Order 2011 and Regulations as well as other prescribed conditions of Registration.
- 10) A successful applicant shall be registered as RFA for a validity period of one (1) year and renewable on a yearly basis subject to meeting the prescribed conditions.
- 11) A RFA and the designated Architect registered with BAPEQS are advised to work out terms of agreement specific to their collaboration which could include insurance and other liability considerations.
- 12) The RFA applicant shall abide and comply with any other laws and regulations that are issued in Brunei Darussalam.
